RESPECT YOURSELF

Campers must act in a respectful way at all times. The words we choose, the actions we take, and the decisions we make impact our experience at camp. You should expect to be respected by all Staff and in turn Staff can expect the same from you.

RESPECT THE ENVIRONMENT

Campers must show respect to the environment and all living things. Whether in a school, in the community, or out on the land, a Camper must honour their surroundings. There are many teachings about respect for the land, one of the best we've heard is "*leave only foot prints behind*". Walk in a good way so that others may enjoy the journey as well.

RESPECT OTHERS

Campers must treat other Campers, Staff, and Elders with respect at all times. Personal space and property should be respected. If you find that you have been disrespected, As Indigenous people we have very useful tools to help with this. Communicate with a Staff or Elder and we can take steps together to ensure that we are all walking in a good way.
